For high school students, it is also helpful to bring a copy of the students last report card and a copy of their transcript.

Other general information for student registration:

- Proof of residency that you live in the Fort Calhoun School District
- Kindergarten and 7th grade students will also need to have a physical form completed and given to the office 30 days from the date of registration.
- Any student coming from another state is required to have a physical.
- Forms to release student records from the previous school can be signed at the time of registration.
