NO MORE THAN 112 WRESTELERS WILL BE ALLOWE TO COMPETE!!

Prior to the meet each school will be asked to send the tournament director their planned roster. If the total number of competitors is over 112 each school will be asked to cut one occupied weight class of their choosing until the total number is under 112. Wrestlers

who are not competing are not allowed into this event.

WEIGH-INS: & SKIN CHECKS

Scales will open at 7:30am and weigh-ins will begin at 8:00am. Weigh-ins will be conducted in the auxiliary gym by team in alphabetical order by school. All teams must bring a pre-match weigh-in form the day of the meet.

SEEDING &: DRAWING

Initial seeding will be done automatically by TrackWrestling based on seeding criteria entered into the system by the coaches. Seeding will be based on the below factors:

- Head to head competition
- Common opponents
- Returning state placer
- Returning state qualifier
- Returning Boys Town Invite placer
- Varsity record
- If coaches disagree with Trackwrestling pre-seed, they will have the authority to make changes with a 2/3 majority vote
- Draw the byes

Changes/drops/adds meeting will be immediately following weigh-ins.

HOSPITALITY ROOM/: There will be NO hospitality room but lunch will be served to the coaches,

CONCESSIONS administrators, and bus drivers. There will be NO concession stand.

WATER: Each team should bring their own water cooler to keep in their team camp area. Each

athlete should bring their own water bottle.

PASSES: All Coaches, Wrestlers, Managers, and team personnel will be admitted. Each school can

submit a **Pass List of up to two administrators no later than Thursday, December 10** to the Tournament Director. This list is NOT for family members/spouses/children/etc.

It is for administrators ONLY.

OTHER INFO:

 All coaches, athletes, managers, bus drivers, and any other team personnel will be required to wear masks at all times when not competing.

- Only wrestlers who are competing or on deck may be on the floor. All other wrestlers need to stay in their camps until they are on deck or competing.
