Game Day Guidelines - Wrestling

Public Attendance/Spectators	No spectators will be allowed at Boys Town home athletic events.
Facility Capacity	 Only team personnel, two administrators, and essential event personnel will be allowed at Boys Town athletic events.
Masks/Face Coverings	 Coaches will be required to wear masks at all times. Athletes will be required to wear masks while warming up and at any time when not in competition.
Pre-Screenings	 Athletes will screen for COVID symptoms at home. Anyone with any COVID symptoms is asked to not attend.
Wrestling Matches	 Wrestlers will not shake hands with officials at any time. Wrestlers will not shake hands with opposing coaches after a match. Officials will not raise the winner's hand. Wrestlers are not allowed matside at any time except when they are on deck.
Cheerleaders	No visiting cheerleaders will be allowed at events.
Locker Rooms	 Locker rooms for visiting teams will be available upon request. If visiting team requests a locker room, all athletes will be required to wear masks at all times while inside the facility.
Concessions	 There will be no concession stand. All athletes will be asked to use their own water bottle.
Bathrooms	 Social distancing is expected. Masks are required to be worn in bathrooms.
Team Benches	 Wrestlers will social distance in their camps. Boys Town wrestlers will stay in the wrestling room unless competing or on deck during the Boys Town Invite.
Entrance/Exits	No spectators will be allowed at Boys Town home athletic events.
Athletic Training Room	No outside use of the Athletic Training room will be allowed unless it's an emergency.
