The 2021 Northridge-Tiger Invitational Golf Tournament will be held at the Northridge Country Club in Tekamah, Nebraska, on Thursday, May 13, starting at 9:00 AM. We will be using a shotgun start. A coaches' meeting will be held at 8:30 AM. Any coaches who wish to golf preceding the competitors will go off the number one tee at 8:45 AM.

The tournament will consist of 18 holes of medal play. We will be playing the white tees on the front nine and the blue tees on the back nine.

Fee for the tournament is \$85 per school.

Tekamah-Herman COVID-19 Guidelines

Masks are required under the following conditions:

1. Prior to competition while teams arrive, and competitors and coaches are gathering within 6 feet of others. (Masks may be removed during competition.)
2. Anytime the clubhouse is entered.
3. Prior to entering of the designated scoring area.
4. During the awards ceremony when within 6 feet of others.

Please plan your arrival for minimal gathering of competitors prior to the rules meeting and start of play.

If bad weather occurs everyone should return to their vehicles rather than the clubhouse.

Scorecards will be distributed to each player. Scorecards will not be exchanged or require signatures.

1. Upon completion of the round players will enter the designated scoring area to review and verify their scores verbally with the scoring official.
2. A scorecard will be deemed returned when the player has verbally verified their hole-by-hole scores with the scoring official and has left the designated scoring area.

Attending and removal of flagsticks is permitted. It is recommended that the player that removes the flagstick be the one to replace it.

Lunch will be served outdoors (Weather permitting). If weather conditions require lunch to be served inside, social distancing of 6 feet should occur between individuals.

Awards will be held outdoors (Weather permitting). If weather conditions are poor the awards ceremony will be canceled, and coaches will pick up all awards.
