Play:	18 Holes medal play.	
	The top 16 ranked golfers (based on average score) start on hole 1 in tee times9:00, 9:08, 9:16, 9:24. The remaining golfers will be sent in a wave format according to team rank to start on the back 9 with a 9:30 shotgun start. **This may change if the number of entries is not conducive to this format**	
	Sudden victory playoff for individual champion. Scorecard playoffs will be used to break all other ties. Team ties for first, second and third will be determined by playoff of low four boys of team only. USGA rules will govern play, in addition to course rules and rules outlined in the 2020-21 NSAA Boy's Golf Manual.	
Scorecards:	Exchange scorecards prior to start of play. Each player and the person keeping that player's score will be required to confirm the players score each hole immediately after each hole is completed and prior to tee-off on the next hole. Scorecards must be signed and checked by: Player & Player keeping your score	
Course:	Tee off at the <b><u>BROWN</u></b> tees. Fairway yard markers: Blue = 200 yards to the center of the green White = 150 yards to the center of the green Red = 100 yards to the center of the green All other yard markers are on the sprinkler heads in the fairway. Red, black, and blue flags on the green indicate front, middle and back. Additional course information will be given at the meeting.	

Awards:	Team medals for First, Second & 7 Team trophies for Champion & Ru Medals to the top 15 individual pla	inner-up.
Lunch:	A lunch will be available for playe	rs, coaches, and spectators.
