Baseball:	Baden Perfection Pro 3B-PPRO-03. We ask that each team provide 6 baseballs to use in the tournament.
Passes:	A maximum of 26 players/coaches/team personnel are allowed free admittance. (22 of which can be suited players) Each school will also be given 8 free admissions for administrators and supervisory personnel. Please send your list of supervisors to tracy.douglas@hpstigers.org
Home Team:	Home team will be the higher seed for all games.
Locker Rooms: Will be available.	
Warm-up:	Teams may schedule a time to use the batting cages located to the west of Duncan. Contact Coach Blake Marquardt to schedule a time - <u>blake.marquardt@hpstigers.org</u>
	Field Warm-up *30 min to game time Home team in/out *20 min Visitor *10 min Umpire meeting *5 min Starting line-ups (go to 1 st base line)/National anthem/Play ball.
Concessions:	Will be provided by the Hastings Booster Club organization. No outside food or drink will be allowed inside the gates of Duncan Field.
Water:	Water will be provided in each dugout.
Hospitality:	Will be located in the east booth for coaches, administrators and tournament workers.

Tournament Play & 10-Run Rule: All games, even those suspended due to weather, are scheduled for seven innings. The 10-run rule is the only reason a game can be shortened. If a team is 10 or more runs ahead at the end of five innings or at the end of any subsequent inning, the game will end.

***Duncan Field has a turf infield. Sunflower seeds and snacks with shells are prohibited anywhere in the facility. Please communicate this to your fans. Gum and food are prohibited on the artificial turf itself.
