Note:

3 Rivers Health Department adopted guidance for COVID-19 clusters and outbreaks.

- *Multiple cases compromised of at least (3) students, teachers, or staff within a specific \*core group meeting criteria for a probable or confirmed school-associated COVID-19 case; with symptom onset or positive test result with 14 days of each other.*

*\*Core Group: includes but not limited to extracurricular activities (including sports, clubs, performances), cohort groups, classroom, before/after school care, etc.*

*Directly from 3 Rivers Health Department*

What does the above mean: If 3 or more positive COVID case are confirmed in a specific area, 3 Rivers is coming into our building and contact tracing. If your student is found to be an “exposed” person, they will be quarantined by the authority of the Health Department and DHHS. Fort Calhoun Schools will have no control over this. Exceptions to this quarantine will be students who were masked or vaccinated at the time of the exposure.
