<u>SCENARIO</u>		<u>ACTION</u>
Any student who has tested positive for COVID.		Isolation for 10 days from onset of symptoms or positive test. Must be symptom free for 24 hours.
Any student who has had a confirmed exposure to COVID but is not symptomatic.		<p>Two Options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Return to school, self-monitor for symptoms for 14 days. Masking is required. 2. Isolate at home for 10 days. <p>If student becomes symptomatic within those 14 days they will then isolate 10 days from onset of symptoms.</p> <p>If student has no symptoms and test negative after day 5, they can return to school after day 7, and after 24 hours of being symptom free.</p>
Any student who has a household exposure. Lives with someone who has tested positive.		<p>Two Options:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Fully Vaccinated: Return to school, self-monitor for symptoms for 14 days. Masking is required. 2. Not Vaccinated: Isolate at home for 10 days. <p>If student has no symptoms and tests negative after day 5, they can return to school after day 7, and after 24 hours of being symptom free.</p> <p>If student becomes symptomatic within those 10 days, they will then isolate 10 days from onset of symptoms.</p>
A student is exhibiting any one of the following: sudden onset of cough, shortness of breath or loss of taste or smell.		Isolation for 10 days from onset of symptoms. If student tests negative after day 5 they can return to school after day 7, and after 24 hours of being symptom free.

**Vaccinated students will only self-monitor and will continue to attend school.
