Fort Calhoun COVID-19 Flow Chart Updated January 5th, 2022

<u>SCENARIO</u> <u>ACTION</u>

Any student who has tested positive for COVID.



Isolation for 5 days from onset of symptoms or positive test. Must be symptom free for 24 hours. Masking is required for additional 5 days.

Any student who has had a confirmed exposure to COVID but is not symptomatic.



Two Options:

- 1. Return to school, self-monitor for symptoms for 10 days. Masking is required.
- 2. Isolate at home for 5 days.Masking is required for additional 5 days.

If student becomes symptomatic within those 10 days they will then isolate 5 days from onset of symptoms. Masking is required for additional 5 days.

Any student who has a household exposure. Lives with someone who has tested positive.



Two Options:

- 1. Fully Vaccinated: Return to school, self-monitor for symptoms for 10 days. Masking is required.
- 2. Not Vaccinated: Isolate at home for 5 days. Masking is required for additional 5 days.

If student becomes symptomatic within those 10 days, they will then isolate 5 days from onset of symptoms. Masking is required for additional 5 days.

A student is exhibiting any one of the following: sudden onset of cough, shortness of breath or loss of taste or smell.



Isolation for 5 days from onset of symptoms. Must be symptom free for 24 hours. Masking is required for additional 5 days.

**3 Rivers Health Department:

- **Masked students will only self-monitor and will continue to attend school.
- **Vaccinated students will only self-monitor and will continue to attend school.
