I hope you're all having a great summer and looking forward to the upcoming school year.

Sports physicals need to be completed and turned into the main office for all incoming 7–12 athletes before athletes may participate and compete. Athletes won't be able to participate in any activities starting August 8, 2022 for high school and August 22, 2022 for junior high without a sports physical. The sports physical must take place after May 1, 2022 to qualify them for the 2022–2023 school year. Return a copy of the physical to the high school office when completed. The specific line we are looking for is "the athlete is cleared without restrictions to participate in athletics."

Parental Consent Forms must also be turned into the main office before any athlete may participate in their activity. Parental Consent Forms can be found on the first page of the Fort Calhoun Activities Handbook. Coaches from each activity will hand all athletes the handbook before the first day of practice. Signed forms can be returned to your coach or main office.
