 - (give specific examples that help tell their story from your perspective)

We've had some feedback from the selection committee. They have asked us to stress the importance of the comment box to the evaluator. Really try to put specific examples in the comment box. You do not need to write a recommendation letter in that spot - use it to really hone in on one example to demonstrate the student's GRIT or even to focus on a single trait they are looking for like Tenacity or Integrity.

Both of these examples are good but one paints a more compelling picture of the candidate for the committee ~

XXX is a very hard working student. She is an outstanding student, very positive in class, and contributes to our class discussions. She is very caring and works well with others both peers and adults. XXX has always had a job outside of school and is not afraid of physical labor. After all, she works in a horse barn on a daily basis and she plans to someday manage her own barn boarding and training horses.

The G.R.I.T. scholarship would go a long way in helping XXX accomplish the dreams that she has set for herself - she is definitely one young woman that has the work ethic and tenacity to get there so I know this scholarship would mean a lot to her and her family.

XXX is hands down the most driven, focused, and hard working student I have known in my career. I have known her since elementary school when she (with her mom's assistance began caring for our youngest daughter). XXX was already raising guinea pigs and selling them to the local pet store to save money for horse riding lessons. Little did I know how strong this common little girl passion was for her...

Later XXX, was the first non-senior to ever create an action plan and present it to the administration to earn work release / on the job training as a junior. As a senior she took an online class through the University of Nebraska's technical agriculture class and a high school accounting class so she could see which direction to head career-wise. In the end, she made the mature decision that a business degree is probably the best way to afford the horses in her future and would allow her the most opportunities. I have no doubt she will be amazing at whatever she does – if the girl can muck stalls, carry feed, and break horses day after day no matter the weather she has the grit to accomplish anything.
