Request: Nebraska Game and Parks classroom fishery program

- Estimated total cost approximately \$1,000
- Requesting as much as PFE can give, preferably at least $1 / 3$ of the cost, more is appreciated.
- Plan to seek private funds/grants or use the science curriculum budget for the remaining amount.
- What it Pays for:
- Initial supplies to start a classroom mini fishery. Examples of some items includes:

■ 55 gallon tank (most expensive component),

- Chiller,

■ Trout Rearing Kit,

- Fish eggs
- Water testing equipment, experimental equipment, and other tools required to study the water and fish.
- Trout to dissect
- Curriculum
- Teacher Training provided by Nebraska Game and Parks Commision
- Teacher Support and equipment maintenance provided by Nebraska Game and Parks Commision
- Future expenses for this program:
- School plans to include these expenses into science budget, so at this time, not requesting funds from PFE for these expenses:
- \$100-\$200 each year covers:
- Equipment maintenance
- Supply replenishment (eggs, testing strips, etc)
- Nebraska Game \& Parks teacher support
- Field Trip
- Trout Dissection
- Goal of this program:
- To teach students biology, aquaponics, fishery science, anatomy, biology, ecology, water chemistry etc.
- Engage students in something that interests them (ie. fishing, hunting etc)
- Students will be able to count and track each egg and fish while also doing other scientific monitoring and experiments of water chemistry, biology, aquaponics, etc to ensure a healthy harvest of fish
- Once fish are grown, students get to go off-site to a fishery or pond/lake and let them out into the wild.
- Students will also get to dissect trout that Nebraska Game and Parks Commission will provide. These are trout harvested from Nebraska fisheries and ponds.
- Why this program:
- It is difficult to engage male youth (at Fort Calhoun) in math and science, but teachers have noticed a strong interest in hunting, fishing, etc. so the hope is this will help captivate students and improve learning.
- Last year, Fort Calhoun implemented curriculum into science focused around aquaponics, fishery science, and fish dissection which seemed to engage and captivate students.
- This program would take this to an even more in-depth level.
- Timeline:
- November -
- Teacher training
- Ashlie has already been accepted
- December or sooner -
- Tank needs to be acquired to fill it and balance the water chemistry
- Water chemistry must be balanced for at least a month before eggs
- January -
- Eggs arrive
- Officers will review the budget and contact Ashlie how much it can contribute.
