

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For our Preschool Families:

The first day of preschool will be Monday, August 18th. Morning preschool is from 8:00 am – 11:15 am and afternoon preschool is from 11:50 am – 3:05 pm. In addition to preschool on Monday through Thursday, there will be preschool on the following days:

- Morning preschool October 22nd, November 26th, and February 18th, from 8:00 am - 11:15 am.
- Afternoon preschool October 23rd, December 19th, and February 19th from 8:00 am - 11:15 am.

Before the school year begins, please bring a copy of your child's birth certificate and current immunization records. The first tuition payment is due on or before August 1, 2025. Payment for each subsequent month will be due on or before the 20th of the month. There will be a grace period of five days if payment is not received by the 20th. Payments can be mailed to the elementary school (PO Box 430 Fort Calhoun, NE 68023), brought to the elementary office during school hours, or by setting up automatic payments through eFunds. Tuition is \$150 per month.
