The Washington County FOP Lodge #36 Scholarship fund awards 'three' scholarships per school year to 3 different high school seniors who reside within Washington County, NE.

Scholarships will be awarded to individuals planning to pursue a degree in the Criminal Justice field at an accredited college, university, or technical program of higher education.

In the event a lack of eligible applicants are available, the scholarship may be awarded to a member of the existing Washington County Sheriff's Office employees to further their pursuit of a degree in the Criminal Justice field.

Amount of Scholarship(s): One time \$500

- Scholarships will be awarded in the second semester of college the awardee has shown successful completion of their first semester.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must currently be a high school senior (Including home school students).
- Must reside within Washington County, Nebraska.
- Must have a 2.5 GPA or better through seven semesters of high school.
- Must be accepted at an accredited college or university and/or technical school, entering a Criminal Justice related program.

Application Process:

- Applicants shall complete the attached application which shall be signed and notarized.
- Submit a letter of acceptance to a qualifying college or program.
- Complete a minimum of a 250 word letter outlining the student's future goals in Criminal Justice as well as explaining how the scholarship will aid the student in realizing those goals.
- Submit copy of high school transcript.
- Submit a photo.

Evaluation Process:

- Application will be reviewed for eligibility, completeness, and professionalism.
- Applications will be evaluated on the student's application, academic record, extracurricular activities, and letter.
