CSIP Goal: The district will develop a Mental Health training program for both parents and staff.

Strategies:

- * The district will use the student Mental Health surveys to arrange training opportunities including speakers and assemblies to speak to identified Mental Health issues.
- * The district will work with staff and train them how to deal with students with Mental Health issues.
- * The district will publish mental health articles and provide staff development opportunities for all staff members regarding mental health.
- * The district will develop opportunities for parents to learn more about Mental Health issues in school age students.

Success Criteria:

- * Staff will understand current Mental Health issues affecting our student body.
- * The staff will have a more keen understanding of what Mental Health issues look like.
- * The staff will be able to identify students in crisis.
- * Parents will have an understanding of Mental Health issues in school-aged students.

Progress Monitoring:

- * Include Mental Health Questions in parent surveys.
- * Teachers participate in mental Health staff development.
- * Alicap training/evaluation
- * Teacher reflection opportunities

Monitor and Adjust:

- * Parent Surveys
- * Staff surveys
- * Provide results of the student risk surveys to the staff.
- * Share information with Mental Health Committee.
- * Set priorities for the district for the following year.
