# PEP BAND

## **POLICIES**

- 1. Pep Band plays at all home volleyball, boys basketball, and girls basketball games, with the following exceptions:
  - A. We do not play when there is wrestling on the same night as a basketball game.
  - B. We do not play during Christmas vacation.
- 2. When you see the word "Tournament" on the calendar, **plan on playing** until you hear something to the contrary.
  - A. It is likely we will not play for the opening game of a tournament—unless its at home—but, nevertheless, refer to No. 2 above.
  - B. When all else fails.....ask.
- 3. **Read** the <u>school calendar</u> carefully. It is **YOUR** responsibility to know the schedule.
- 4. You are expected to be present at Pep Band unless you have a **fantastic** legitimate excuse for not being there. Being present at a game without playing will be considered negative attitude and will be an automatic half letter grade reduction in your quarter grade.
- 5. You must ride the bus to play at away pep bands unless you have made arrangements in advance.
- 6. Your parents expect you to be at a supervised school activity. Outdoors is not supervised. You may not leave the building.

## **PROCEDURES**

#### VOLLEYBALL—

- 1. You should **BE** back IN your seats by the time either team's score reaches 18.
- 2. If we win the set, we will play School Song and then another selection.
- 3. If we lose the set, we will play another selection and then School Song.
- 4. We will not play at the end if we should happen to lose the game.

### BASKETBALL—

- 1. Be back in your seats when 2:00 minutes remain in the half (first or second.)
- 2. Half time will always start with School Song as the team leaves the floor.
- 3. Several selections should be in order for the half time.
- 4. We will not play at the end if we should happen to lose the game.
